Confession

July 2, 2017

“If my people who belong to me will humbly pray, seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, forgive their sin, and heal their land.”

-- 2 Chronicles 7:14

While enslaved in Babylon, Daniel prayed to God for restoration of his people held there in captivity. He confessed his sin, acknowledged God's justice and pled for His mercy (Daniel 9:1-19). And God answered his prayer! The final part of this prayer is printed below. We can use Daniel's prayer to confess our own sin and pray for the healing of our nation:

- † But now, our God, listen to your servant's prayer and pleas for help.
- † Shine your face on your ruined sanctuary, for your own sake, my Lord. Open your ears, my God, and listen!
- † Open your eyes and look at our devastation. Look at the city called by your name!
- † We pray our prayers for help to you, not because of any righteous acts of ours but because of your great compassion.
- † My Lord, listen! My Lord, forgive! My Lord, pay attention and act! Don't delay!
- † My God, do all this for your own sake, because your city and your people are called by your name.
