Confession

The Fourth Commandment

January 14, 2018

Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy. Six days you shall labor and do all your work, but the seventh day is a Sabbath to the Lord your God. On it you shall not do any work, neither you, nor your son or daughter, nor your manservant or maidservant, nor your animals, nor the alien within your gates. For in six days the Lord made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that is in them, but He rested on the seventh day. Therefore the Lord blessed the Sabbath day and made it holy.

--Exodus 20:8-11

Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy.

As you pray this week, consider the following:

- † What do I usually do on Sunday?
- † What can I do to keep Sundays holy (set apart to God, different from all other days)?
- † Do I see Sunday as a provision and benefit from God (for rest, rejuvenation and oneness with Him)? How?

- † Whether I choose not to work/shop, continue my normal daily routine or to joyfully serve Jesus, do I take this commandment seriously? If so, do I have the peace of God?
